Thanks to Lissy of the Forks Chamber of Commerce, we just learned that the Lincoln Theatre has been closed since February of 2014, and is threatened—if not by demolition, by being turned into something not Theatre- or Twilight-like.

Happily, a group of concerned Port Angelites rallied and created a “**Light up the Lincoln**” campaign to raise funds for purchasing the theatre, preserving it, and turning it into a nonprofit community arts center with film screenings, concerts, corporate meetings and parties.
