You must register yourself or your team (up to 4 people) upon arriving at SMD headquarters. At 8am every morning, a new set of GPS coordinates will be announced via the **SMD Instagram account**: http://instagram.com/stepheniemeyerday = You'll need an Instagram account.

Your mission is to find the geo cache container found at each day's location. The clue within the container will help you solve that day's puzzle, leading you one step closer to finding Bella—the ultimate goal.

The last set of geo cache location coordinates will be provided at 8am on Sunday morning. This container's clue will *only* be available to the **first team to arrive**, and will provide a final set of GPS coordinates that will lead you to Bella and an exclusive Olympic Coven experience!
